Arruda dos Vinhos



The municipality of Arruda dos Vinhos (30 square miles county) is located 18,64 miles North from Lisbon; with 13 400 inhabitants, comprising the parishes of Arruda dos Vinhos, Cardosas, Arranhó e S. Tiago dos Velhos. Featuring a rural landscape it also holds industries and services.

The oldest official document dates from 12th century (1172) when the King Afonso Henriques donates the county to the Order of Saint James (S. Tiago) founding the municipality. On January 15th 1517 King Manuel issues a new charter confirming the county importance. During his reign, the king sought refuge in Arruda from a plague outbreak raging in Lisbon. He survived and gave orders to change the name of the church patron from "Saint Mary of Arruda" to "Our Lady of Salvation" and a few years later (1525-1531) the church was rebuilt.

Arruda dos Vinhos owns a quite unique natural heritage with sunny valleys, vineyards and field crops, inviting everyone to the practice of outdoor activities such as hiking and horseback riding.
